## Senior iPad Buyout Schedule

Students will not be eligible for the buyout price if they leave the school or fail to graduate. These prices do not include any outstanding fees that may incur due to misuse or damage. ## NHS Blood Drive - April 8th

The National Honor Society will be sponsoring another blood drive on Wednesday, April 8<sup>th</sup>. Students may begin signing up for the blood drive during the week of March 30-April 2 during lunchtime. Students must be at least 17 years old in order to give blood without a parent's consent. Sixteen year old students that have a completed parent consent form with them on the day of the blood drive will be allowed to give blood. The Red Cross recommends following these guidelines before giving blood:

- Get a good night's sleep before the blood drive
- 2) Eat well & drink plenty of fluids in the days leading up to the drive
- 3) Drink at least 16 oz. of caffeine free fluid 3-4 hours before giving blood

Students must also have a photo ID before they can give blood.
