RED Program Provides Text Message & Email Alerts Reminder

This is just a reminder about the RED Alert program that allows teachers, coaches, and administration to send out text messages and email alerts to parents and students reminding them of activities that are going to take place in the near future.

You may signup for the RED alert program by going to the USD #499 website. If you hold your cursor over the top line that says Ren Learning, Google, etc., another line will appear. Click on the Alert Signup link to begin registering. You will be able to select from a wide array of subscription groups, from athletics to specific grade levels-Kindergarten through 12th grade. This will not replace the School Reach phone calls; it is simply another line of school to home communication. If you have any questions, please contact the school.

Semester Finals

Semester finals will be held for Blue day (odd) classes on Thursday, December 18 and for White day (even) classes on Friday, December 19. All students are required to take the 1st semester finals. The finals policy for second semester is: Students will be exempt from finals if they meet the following requirements: A - may have 2 absences in any one class B - may have 1 absence in any one class C - may have 0 absences D or F - must take finals The student's lowest grade will be used to determine which category will be used. (i.e. a student with 7 A's and 1 B must use the B criteria and is only allowed 1 absence in any one class)
