

The Spanish club is holding their annual catalog fundraiser. All orders are due on November 1st. The items will be delivered at the beginning of December. The money raised will help students


to have food and t-shirt money, as well as, help with cost of field trips they take to dance performances, concerts, and Silver Dollar City. Thanks in advance for your support!!!
