## **Kansas State Assessment Testing**

Sophomores and some juniors will be taking the Kansas State Assessment tests beginning in March. Kansas state tests are given at the following levels:

Reading – 10<sup>th</sup> grade & some 11<sup>th</sup> graders

Math – 10<sup>th</sup> grade & some 11<sup>th</sup> graders

Science – 11<sup>th</sup> grade

Social Studies – 11<sup>th</sup> grade

Students will receive scores on their tests in one of the following five categories: Exemplary, Exceeds Standard, Meets Standard, Approaches Standard, and Academic Warning. Sophomores and/or juniors that score in the Meets Standard, Exceeds Standard, or Exemplary categories on the math and reading assessments will be exempt from second semester finals during their sophomore and junior years. Sophomores that do not score in the top three categories on either the math or reading assessments will have another opportunity to take the test(s) during their junior year.

The 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Big Man on Campus competition - a beauty pageant for GUYS – will be held on Saturday, February 18. Senior and junior boys (who volunteer) will be competing in the following areas: talent, evening gown, and interview.
