## Ordering a Transcript from LCC

### Cost for the transcript is \$10

1. You will need the address for the college where you are having your transcript sent. Make sure you send it to the Admissions Department. You will also need a major credit card or debit card.
2. Go to the LCC homepage – [www.labette.edu](http://www.labette.edu)
3. Under the “Admissions” pull down menu select Transcripts
4. There is a section on this page that reads, “To request an official transcript online, [click here.](#)”
5. Make sure you choose the “After Grades are Posted” option so your transcript will include all of your grades, including the ones you are currently enrolled in.
6. Fill out the required information
7. If you have any questions, see Mrs. Simmons.

**If you took any college classes, you will need to have your LCC transcript sent to your new college in order for you to get credit for them. Otherwise, you will have to retake them at your new college**
