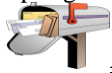

SUMMER SCHOOL: Letters for Summer School have been sent home with students that teachers feel could benefit from some extra help. Summer School will be held June 4th-22nd. Grades K-2 will attend at Spring Grove. A free breakfast will be served at 7:30 a.m. and lunch will be served at 12:00. Meals will be served in the High School Cafeteria. Transportation will be provided, if requested. An adult must be home and visible to the bus driver when the bus drops off your child. Parents are welcome to pick up their child at 12:00, however, the bus route will not begin until 12:30 each day after students have eaten lunch. If students are not riding the bus they will need to be picked up promptly at 12:00 noon.
