  - ACT composite score 21 or higher
  - ACT WorkKeys Scaled Score 80 or higher, (Level 5 or higher)
  - KAP Science 3 or higher

  - All A's for the semester

Galena High School junior and senior students are given the opportunity to take college classes through Labette Community College while they are still in high school based on their grades, attendance, and teacher recommendations. College enrollment counseling will begin the week of April 11-14. Mrs. Simmons will be meeting with each student that is planning on taking college classes during the 2022-23 school year to discuss the college the student is interested in attending, and whether the LCC classes will transfer to the college of his/her choice.
