

Battle of the Bulldogs

The Battle of the Bulldogs program is designed to boost school spirit. Throughout the quarter, classes (freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior) are given the opportunity to earn points based on their involvement in activities. These activities include: attendance at volleyball, football, and basketball games, concerts, plays, etc., dressing up for Pep Club themes, class chants at pep assemblies, Bulldog Blue Friday's, homecoming/Red Ribbon Week dress up days, etc. The classes can also earn points based on biweekly attendance, tardies, quarter grades/Honor Roll, and Parent-Teacher Conference attendance. Since the classes each have a different number of students, the points awarded are based on the percentage of people participating in each activity.

The points are accumulated throughout the quarter and the class with the highest number of points at the end of each quarter will get a movie afternoon in the Performing Arts Center.

Platinum Bulldog

As part of our Behavior MTSS, GHS is continuing a program called Platinum Bulldog. There are two phases to this program. Phase 1 of the program allows students that pass all classes with a C or above, have a 90% attendance rate, and have no discipline referrals to be able to enjoy a free seminar with drinks & snacks while they play games or just hang out in the Commons. Those students that do not meet the above criteria will be in the classrooms working on makeup assignments, etc. Phase 2 of the program is for junior and senior students only. Students that meet the criteria for Phase 1, with the exception of having to have all A's or B's, are allowed out of seminar on a specified date. Platinum Bulldog Phase 1 will take place right after midterms each quarter. Phase 2 of Platinum Bulldog will be held at the end of each quarter.
