KEEPING OUR SCHOOL HEALTHY: WHEN TO STAY HOME



- 🐾 Your child must be fever-free (under 100.4°F) for 24 hours without taking fever-reducing medications like acetaminophen or ibuprofen.
- 🐾 Your child must go 24 hours without throwing up or having loose stools, and they need to be able to normally tolerate eating and drinking.
- 🐾 If diagnosed with a bacterial infection requiring medication (such as strep throat), your child must stay home for 24 hours after taking their first dose of antibiotics.
