FUN IN THE SUN: Fun in the Sun is tomorrow, Wednesday, May 26th. We have lots of fun activities planned for our students PreK-2 for both indoors and outdoors. School will be dismissed at the regular dismissal time. As with all our school parties and activities this year, Fun In The Sun will be limited to students and staff only.

PRESCHOOL: Preschool students will come for Fun in the Sun at their regular class times and will need to be picked up at the regular class dismissal time. Wednesday, May 26th, will be the last day for Preschool students.

LAST DAY OF SCHOOL: The last day of school for grades K-2 is Thursday, May 27th. School will dismiss at 11:00 a.m. No lunch will be served. Busses will run their usual routes at 11:00 a.m. Please make sure you have made arrangements for someone to be at the bus stop or to pick up your child at school. Please notify the office of any changes so that all children get to the right place. Thank you.

FUN SUMMER PROGRAM: Registration forms for the Summer Program need to be turned in by Wednesday, May 26th. The Summer Program will run from June 7th to July 2nd. Breakfast and lunch will be served at the High School. Bus transportation will be provided for those who qualify. Transportation rules are listed on the registration form. ONLINE ENROLLMENT: Emails have been sent out with instructions to enroll your child for the 2021-2022 school year. Please make sure you are enrolling in the correct enrollment portal. All PreK-2nd grade students who attended Spring Grove during the 2020-2021 school year are considered Returning Students. For those who have not set up their parent portal, instructions have been sent home in a school envelope with your child. Be on the lookout for these emails and check backpacks for the envelope. YEARBOOKS: Time is running out to order a yearbook. Orders must be in by May 27th. To guarantee that your child receives a yearbook, you need to place your order now. There is no guarantee that there will be extra yearbooks. The easiest way to order is to go to the school website, scroll down to "More Headlines" and click on "Yearbook On Sale" and select the option you need: "Order a Galena High School Yearbook" or "Order a Galena PreK-8th Yearbook". It will then open up to the Josten's site and "Order My Yearbook". Click the box and it will take you to the page to enter your child's information. The next box that will pop up will list your child's name, grade, and Liberty Elementary, click continue. Just follow the instructions. ALL Prek - 8th grade yearbooks are ordered through Liberty Elementary. There are no paper order forms this year.
